RULES:

CHILI Defined by the International Chili Society as any kind of meat or combination of meats, cooked with various spices and other ingredients, with the exception of BEANS and PASTA which are strictly forbidden. No garnish is allowed. This will be the definition used for our competition.

LOGISTICS: **Each team will need to have at least a 6 QT crockpot of chili.** Each team will be given one (1) bowl for Judging. The Bowl will be filled with the contestant's CHILI and supplied to the **Floor Monitor** to be taken to the judges for tasting. **Chili must be tasted by the head cook** in view of the **Floor Monitor** before being taken by the Floor Monitor. Please bring a copy of your recipe to the contest. Following the judging, the team should be prepared for public tasting.

SPACE: Each team will be provided a 6 foot table and 2 chairs.

ENTRY FEE: **None.** This event is open to EOSC faculty, staff and students, as well as community businesses, organizations and individuals.

DEADLINE: Entry form must be received by November 5th by the EOSC Office of Institutional Advancement to ensure a space in the competition.

CHECK-IN: **Check-in will begin at 5 p.m.** Each team is responsible for their own table coverings. All booths are to be set up and ready to operate by 6 p.m.
