

EOSC CURRENT STUDENT SELF-ENROLLMENT INSTRUCTIONS

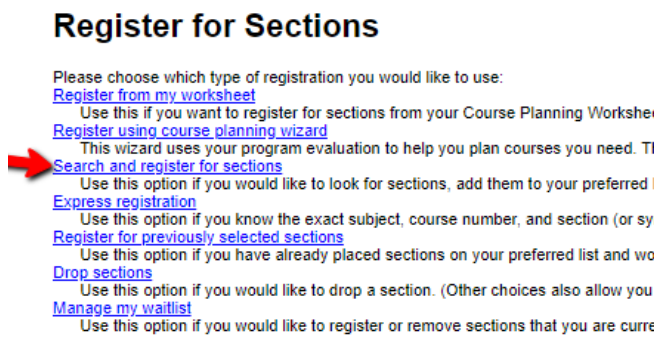
1. Log into WebAdvisor and select the *Student* menu. From there, click *Register for Sections*.



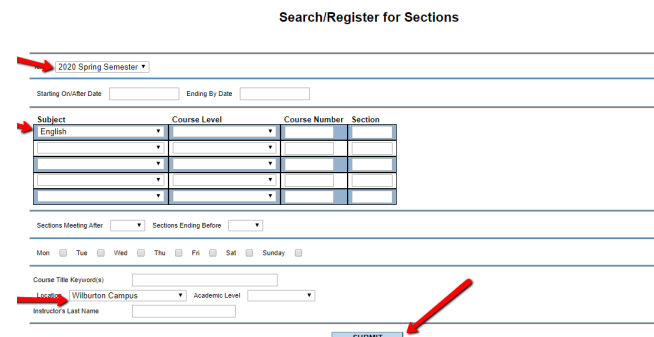

2. Click on *Search and Register for Sections*.



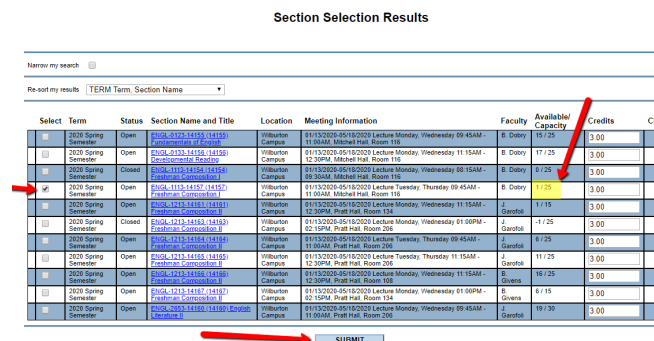
3. Search for sections after first selecting:
