



TRANSFER ARTICULATION

The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education (OSRHE) has provided a policy of articulation among the higher education institutions of the State System. Any student who completes an Associate in Science (A.S.) or Associate in Arts (A.A.) from a state-supported two-year college will not be required to complete the specific general education requirements of the state university institution to which the student transfers as long as the student transfers into a program in the university's college of arts and sciences.

Eastern also endeavors to establish productive articulation relationships with universities to facilitate smooth transfer for associate degree graduates seeking bachelor's degrees. See an advisor for assistance.
